About INTERVIEWS

Jadaliyya's Interview Page is a hub for all interviews published on Jadaliyya, including those in print, audio, and video formats. It features three categories of interviews: interviews conducted for Jadaliyya publication; interviews featuring Jadaliyya Co-Editors; interviews published elsewhere but considered important enough to be republished on Jadaliyya.

Jadaliyya Interview Specifications

- The Interview submission should Identify: the interviewer, the interviewee, the topic, the language the interview was conducted in, and whether video/audio is available.
- The interview submission should include translator information when needed.
- Hyperlink the names of those identified as interviewers and interviewees.
- If interviewer chooses to remain anonymous, identify as "Jadaliyya affiliate."

Review Process:

Jadaliyya INTERVIEWS editorial team, review all submissions. The decision-making process is done by consensus. If an article needs further work, one editorial member makes comments, which are then sent to the author for review. Thais process can take anywhere from a couple of hours to two weeks depending on the extent of edits necessary and culminates in the publication of the article.

Interview Format Specifications

Muhammed Chang (MC): This is the first question you are asking the interviewee.

John Smith (JS): This is the first answer the interview is providing you with.

MC: This is the second question you are asking the interviewee.

JS: This is the second answer the interviewee is providing you with.

Submission Specifications:

Please ensure the following is included with your submission:

- An image related to the content of the post. The size must be 300 by 400 pixels, and a specific source must be included.
- 2-3 quotes from the submission and include in the .doc file at the of the submission.
- Comma-separated tags at the bottom of the post based on what the post is about: e.g., Egypt, revolution, protests, army.
- Hyperlink words in the article if they refer to links on the internet. We encourage hyperlinks. Please avoid footnotes & embed them as hyperlinks if possible.
- Sign and email the copyright Release Form (download here)

Checklist for Submissions:

- ✓ Submit an image related to the content of the post
- ✓ Hyperlink words in your article if they refer to links on the internet.
- ✓ Select 2-3 quotes from your post.
- ✓ Include commaseparated tags based on what your post is about.
- ✓ Sign the copyright Release Form (download <u>here</u>)
